

**Alamo Country Club
Committee/Club/Group Charter**

Nature Park Charter

Purpose: The Nature Park provides a quiet space for Alamo Country Club members and visitors to meditate and enjoy native vegetation.

Scope: It oversees all aspects of the Nature Park including maintaining the Nature Park vegetation and structures.

Responsibilities: Responsibilities include: trimming and planting of trees, shrubs, and plants; keeping waterfall working; weed control; mulching; scheduling workdays; maintaining the gazebo; working with the maintenance supervisor for watering, mowing, ant control, and workdays; overseeing the Memory Plaza and adding new memory stones. The Nature Park maintains certification as a Certified Wildlife Habitat by the National Wildlife Federation. The Committee will provide an annual financial and activity report to the Board of Directors.

Members: There is no formal membership. A Friends of the Nature Park email list is used for communication.

Meetings: There are no regularly scheduled meetings. Workdays are scheduled as needed: usually 2-3 per year. Input and suggestions are solicited from residents.

Project Funding: There are 2 fundraisers per year: 1 dinner and 1 Walk in the Park social. Additional funds come from sales of memory stones and donations.
