Dance Club Charter

Purpose: The Dance Club strives to provide quality and value of entertainment for the residents of Alamo Country Club. Its overall objective is to make each offering even better than the last.

Scope: The Committee organizes and coordinates dances throughout the Winter Texan season of October through March. The dances include but are not limited to: Halloween, Christmas, New Year's Eve, Valentines, St. Patrick's, and Spring Roundup.

Responsibilities: Responsibilities include: book and pay bands, discuss and purchase theme decorations, set-up and decorate Big Hall, assist with setup of lighting and sound systems, offer a variety of extras at dances (i.e.: door prized, 50/50 tickets, food, drinks, contests), sell dance tickets by Committee or through the Golf Shop, advertise events through a variety of sources, submit Chatterbox articles, attend or report at other ACC meetings as required, serve as Master of Ceremonies, and coordinate cleaning of all areas used for the dances. In addition, the Committee collaborates with other committees and groups to benefit the overall well being of ACC. The Committee participates in supporting other projects throughout the community as funds allow and as requested. The Committee will provide an annual financial and activity report to the Board of Directors.

Members: All homeowners are invited to attend meetings and serve as volunteers. Members recommend and vote on an executive committee consisting of a chairperson or co-chair, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Meetings: There is no set schedule for meetings. These are called approximately 3-4 weeks prior to each dance and conducted in accordance with Robert's Rules of Order. A review of operations after a dance for quality improvement can also be called.

Project Funding: Band fees and other expenses for each dance are paid from the profits of the dances out of the Dance Club account.
