Drama Club Charter

Purpose: The Alamo Country Club (ACC) Drama Club provides events to honor veterans, entertain ACC residents, and as a creative outlet for the membership through the Choir and Productions.

Scope: The Drama Club, at a minimum, is responsible for the ACC Choir, the annual Veterans' Day observation, and entertainment each Spring. This is either a play or a variety show. Other offerings may occur as time and volunteers are available.

Responsibilities: It assists in maintaining and replacing the following equipment: microphones, sound board mixer, Tascam Recording unit, amplifiers, monitors, speakers, and pianos (tuning). It provides entertainment and observance of Veterans' Day, and maintain the ACC Choir. The Committee will provide an annual financial and activity report to the Board of Directors.

Members: All ACC residents are eligible for membership in the Drama Club. It isn't necessary to be an actor to join. The Club offers a variety of volunteer opportunities to support its production efforts. The officers, chairperson, vice chairperson, secretary, treasurer, are elected for two-year terms from the membership at every other April meeting.

Meetings: Meetings are held from October to April on the first Wednesday of the month at 10:00 am. If needed, another location date and time may be designated by the **chairperson**. 'Robert's Rules of Order' are followed and meetings are open to all residents.

Project Funding: Drama Club members pay annual dues of \$5.00. Other funding comes from the Veterans' Program/dinner and the Spring play/variety show.
