Alamo Country Club Committee/Club/Group Charter

Committee/Club/Group: Security Support/1st Responders Committee

Purpose: This group addresses the needs of the community to promote safety, security, and assistance during stressful times for homeowners, guests, and ACC Facilities.

Scope: The scope includes ACC common grounds, perimeter fencing, entrance, and exit, also to assist when asked by homeowners during emergencies.

Responsibilities: To offer support as needed during emergent situations. In assisting residents, the committee will maintain confidentiality and privacy. Collaborate with and supports the security personnel. Committee members will assist in special projects and the Annual Meeting, security guard coverage is limited to relieving as needed for meetings or an issue to be addressed in the community. It does not include addressing an issue within the community individually. The committee will report needed repairs, upgrades, or issues to the ACC Board. The committee is responsible to collaborate with other committees and groups. The committee will provide an annual financial and activity report to the ACC BOD.

Members: The group is made up of four officers and other ACC member volunteers. The President of BOD approves the chairperson. The committee elects a co-chairperson, secretary, and treasurer at the first meeting annually. Those present have voting privileges.

Meetings: Meetings are held on the second Monday of each Month. (Oct-April) All members are welcome to attend.

Project Funding: The committee is authorized to raise funds as needed for projects.
