Committee/Club/Group Charter**

Committee/Club/Group: Security Support Committee

Purpose: The Security Support Committee addresses the needs of the community to promote safety and security of homeowners, guests, and ACC facilities.

Scope: The scope includes ACC common grounds, perimeter fencing, and entrance/exit that relate to security issues.

Responsibilities: It collaborates with and supports the security personnel, identifies and coordinates needed repairs and upgrades to the ACC Board. Committee members assist in special projects, the Annual Meeting and Security Guard coverage as needed. Security guard coverage is limited to relieving the employee at the gate in order for them to address an issue; it does not include addressing an issue within the community individually. The Committee reports community security problems like loose stray dogs, and open spots in fencing. The Committee is responsible to collaborate with other committees and groups as work intersects. The committee will provide an annual financial and activity report to the Board of Directors.

Members: The committee is made up of four officers and other ACC members/residents. The President of the Board appoints the chairperson. The committee elects a co-chairperson, secretary, and treasurer at the first meeting annually. Those present have voting privileges.

Meetings: Meetings are held on the second Monday of each month (October – April). All members/residents are welcome to attend meetings.

Project Funding: The Security Support Committee is authorized to raise funds as needed for projects.
